Among the strategic questions these assessments are designed to address are:

- How much market share could be gained by recruiting a new surgeon?
- What is patient leakage within a primary service area? Where are patients going and for which services?
- How are the population dynamics of a community changing and are the services in place to support these patients in the future?

Market assessments shed new light on market dynamics and help leaders better understand utilization patterns.



The Chartis Center for Rural Health offers three different types of market assessments:

- **Patient Outmigration:** A detailed analysis of patients from a hospital's service area(s) who are seeking treatment at another facility. This assessment provides detail into patient leakage volumes, associated service lines and expected revenue impact.
- **Medicare Market Assessment:** A detailed analysis of market share factors for both inpatient and outpatient Medicare cases. This assessment explores strengths and weaknesses within service areas at the DRG and procedure code levels, as well as in-market population health dynamics.
- All Payor Market Assessment: Similar in scope to the Medicare Market Assessment (e.g. inpatient and
 outpatient cases, comparative analytics at the DRG and procedure code levels) but offering a much broader
 scope to encompass all payor types. In-market population health dynamics can also be incorporated into
 this assessment.
